



Shiro Masuyama was born in Tokyo in 1971. Following international residencies in the Irish Museum of Modern Art, Dublin in 2006 and Flax Art Studios in 2009, he moved to Belfast where he has been based ever since. His artistic practice has mainly developed through numerous residencies undertaken all around the world.

Shiro's exhibition at Siamsa Tíre will include photographic portraits and video documentaries of animal shearing projects for **sheep**, **alpaca**, and **camel**, which were realized with local people who have traditional skills in Ireland, Peru and Mongolia; a half-**Irish** and half-**British** art caravan made from his outsider's point of view as Japanese in Northern Ireland*; humorous letter-shaped **chicken** feeders from rural Thailand; houses for **flies** trapped inside West Cork Arts Centre, Skibereen, related to the local history of the Great Famine; and group photographs and T-Shirts from a recent engagement with members of the **local environmental community**.
